Meersbrook Park, Sheffield



With local community support Sheffield Palestine Solidarity Campaign is organising a 24-hour non-stop group run. Entrants will be able to run, jog or walk shifts of a circuit of Meersbrook park. You can choose how long and at what time you would like to run.

Freedom of movement is a human right! Running in the cramped space of a small park is symbolic of the monotonous daily restrictions imposed on the free movement of Palestinians - checkpoints, land theft, army restrictions, settler harassment, the wall... Meersbrook Park is the same size as the seriously overcrowded Tulkarm refugee camp in the West Bank, Palestine, home to 21,000 people.

Raising money The event will raise money for children's educational and play projects in Gaza and funding for women in Palestine to go to university.

Fun in the park Alongside the 24 hour run will be other activities: a lantern craft workshop, music, live poetry, a photographic exhibition, tea and cake in the walled garden and even a penalty shootout versus a women's football team from Bethlehem.
